ABOUT THE ROMANIAN PART OF THE PROJECT:

Volunteer project "Interactive Train to Coolture" in Romania assumes an animation of free time children and young people from Bucharest and promotion of foreign cultures and ideas for volunteering. During the short term EVS we plan to make different workshops and other kind of events for children and youth by using educational and cognitive innovative methods of leisure time (non formal) and organise some happenings and local actions for local community. EVS volunteers themselves will be able to share their passions and learn new social skills

The tasks of the volunteers:

- Sharing culture in a special cultural diversity educational program for the Romanian children in Bucharest and in rural areas
- Working in clinic animation activities for kids in hospitals and social centers
- Promoting a volunteer attitude to disadvantaged and normal youth from Bucharest and rural areas
- Organizing fund raising campaigns, annual events and competitions especially for kids, but also for other different kind of target groups
- Cooperating with other EVS and local volunteers to create promotional events and dissemination materials
- Evaluating every week the activity
 - a. writing the special form
 - b. debating with the all A.C.T.O.R. team

AIMS OF THE PROJECT:

The project aims to raise the awareness of the value and importance of active engagement and active citizenship and as a one of the best instrument to expand or improve competences (skills, knowledge and attitude) for personal, social and professional development.

The main target group of the project are kids and young people with fewer opportunities, therefore the projects develops the solidarity and tolerance among youth by giving a chance to disadvantaged youth, providing them with skills and information for getting active and support them with new opportunities for their future. Moreover the projects fosters mutual understanding and tolerance among youth from different cultures and it gives opportunity to learn about "the unknown" and avoid or combat stereotypes.

PROFILE OF EVS VOLUNTEER

- Speak communicative English

- Be enthusiastic and motivated

FEW WORDS ABOUT CONDITIONS

Support for the volunteers:

We will offer the quick language support in form of the Romanian classes that will take place twice per week. As well each volunteer will have mentor – there will be one mentor for max. of 2 volunteers. We will provide as well 3 supervisors of activities.

On Arrival training

The training will be organized by the staff of our organisation, during the first 3 days of the stay of volunteers

Working hours:

Volunteers will be working 35 hours per week, and will have 2 days off per month of holidays, Saturdays and Sundays are free.

Accommodation:

Volunteers will live in a common flats with 2 or 3 rooms. Every volunteer will have a roommate. The kitchen and the bathrooms are common in every flat. The volunteers can prepare the food on their own.

Every flat has Internet wireless connections. Every volunteer will receive a Romanian SIM card and a transportation card for all local transportation in Bucharest.

Money:

- Pocket money – The volunteer will receive monthly pocket money on – 60euros
- Food allowances - The volunteer will receive monthly food allowance –90 euros
