Solidarity /ˌsɒl.ɪˈdær.ə.ti/ noun

1. Agreement between and support for the members of a group, especially a political group.
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Corporation /ˌkɔː.pərˈeɪ.ʃən/ noun

1. A large group of companies that is controlled together as a single organisation
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Accreditation /əˈkredɪˈteɪʃ(ə)n/ noun

1. An acknowledgement of a person's responsibility for or achievement of something.

Peg /pɛɡ noun

1. A short pin or bolt, typically tapered at one end, that is used for securing something in place, hanging things on, or marking a position.
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Sequin /ˈsiːkwɪn/ noun

1. A small shiny disc sewn on to clothing for decoration
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Bead /biːd/ noun

1. An ornamental plaster moulding resembling a string of beads or having a semicircular cross section
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Sellotape /'sɛlə(ʊ)teɪp/ *noun*

1. Transparent adhesive tape used for sticking objects and materials.



Cotton wool /kɒt.ən 'wʊl/ *noun*

1. Fluffy wadding of a kind originally made from raw cotton, used for cleaning the skin or bathing wounds.



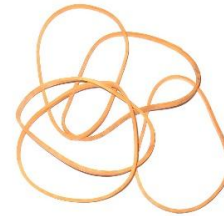
String /strɪŋ/ *noun*

1. A piece of thin rope made by twisting very thin threads together, used for fastening and tying things



Elastic band /noun/

1. A thin, flexible loop that is made of rubber and used to hold things together



Mop /mɒp/ *noun*

1. A tool of thick loose strings or a sponge attached to a handle, used for wiping floors or other surfaces.
