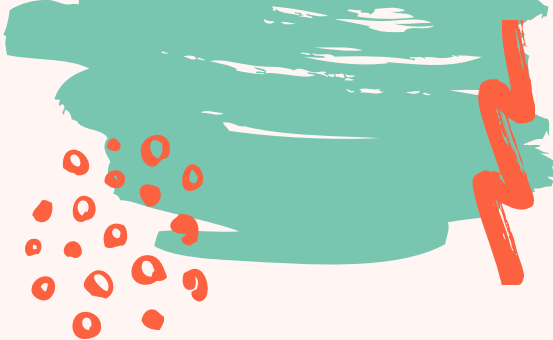

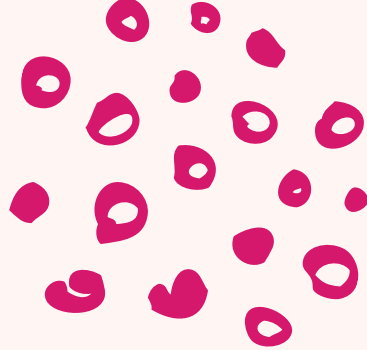

Co tam? – What's up?

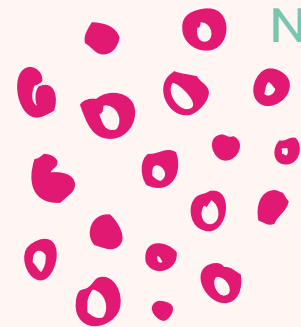
Jak leci? – How is it going?
